


More than just an area to move to, Orison is a community to become a part of. Rediscover a love of local life that extends to the people, places and experiences within it.




### Fresh air and open space in abundance.

Alternatively, the 26-kilometre walking track along the Jacksons Creek invites you to find bliss amidst expansive natural surrounds.







Adding to the already extensive list of stores, eateries and services within reach of Orison, the rich local culture of Sunbury and its surrounds serves up its own taste of the renowned Melbourne experience. Take in an arthouse film with friends of a weekend at Reading Cinemas on the main thoroughfare before sampling the region's finest flavours at Vic's Food & Wine, just around the corner.

Lovers of the local Macedon Ranges wine region will similarly relish the immediacy to Andraos Brothers and Craiglee Vineyard, where world-class drops can be savoured against the undulating plains that slope towards Jacksons Creek.

Beyond the ample spaces to play and explore, children will reap the benefits of excellent local learning.

Orison's own proposed government school will grant you the luxury of precious time spent walking your young ones to and from school. Just 15 minutes away in Sunbury itself, St Anne's is primed to provide a quality primary school education while Salesian and Sunbury Colleges will nurture lifelong learners in later years.

Outside of the spoils of Sunbury, a 15-minute drive will connect you to the Calder Highway, carrying you further northwest to weekends away in Daylesford, Bendigo and Heathcote.
