



"Viridian is set to become Greenvale's premier new neighbourhood, offering one of the last opportunities to live in postcode 3059."


Greenvale is already one of Melbourne's most welcoming and well-established communities. With its schools, parks, shopping centres, sports and recreation facilities, and local destinations, it's a place people love to call home. Viridian has been designed as a new neighbourhood nestled within this setting, adding to what makes Greenvale so special. It is also the last and best land in this remarkable location, offering residents a rare opportunity to build new and enjoy life here now.

"When buyers talk to us, they're often talking to Frazer or I directly," says Jeremy De Zylva, co-director of Resolution Property Group.
"We're there at the start, the middle, and the end of our buyer's journey. For us, it's personal and a privilege."

That involvement runs through everything Resolution does. Jeremy doesn't talk so much about sales numbers or square metre rates. He prefers to talk about people and the creation of communities where Resolution helps families realise their dream lifestyle. "We're not just developing and selling land, we're helping create the place where family stories play out," he notes.

For Jeremy, what makes Viridian in Greenvale particularly exciting is that the surrounding area is completely established. "This isn't the usual case in growth corridors in Melbourne where residents move in and then wait for the café or the school or the park to appear," he notes. "Here, everything you need is already in place from day one. The schools are already open, the shops are already there, the parks and the transport too."

The site's location on Somerton Road itself reinforces its attraction. "With Viridian being located only 25 kilometres north of the Melbourne CBD, it is strategically located in the fast-growing northern growth



corridor of Melbourne," says Frazer East, co-director of Resolution.

"To the south is the Melbourne Airport and Business Park employment cluster and the Airport West Westfield Shopping Centre. To the east, Roxburgh Park has the train station for an easy commute into the city and Roxburgh Village Shopping Centre."

Perhaps the most distinctive feature of Viridian itself is its green spaces. "We don't see existing trees or landscape features as obstacles," Frazer says. "We see them as opportunities. At Viridian, we've included more than two hectares of new parkland to connect with the three-hectare Blossom Drive Conservation Reserve. For a neighbourhood of this size, that's quite extraordinary. It means you can walk out your front door and into a mature landscape and not have to wait for trees to establish themselves."

This approach reflects Resolution's boutique scale. "Unlike some of the bigger names out there, we're not doing 3,000-lot projects," Jeremy explains. "We want to develop communities within established suburbs. That strategy lets us focus on quality and design. The details in the streetscapes, the way the entry feels, the finishing touches that elevate a neighbourhood."

Jeremy notes, "At our Harli project, we went all-electric, zero carbon, and minimum seven-star before the government required it. We set a higher bar because it felt right. At Viridian, we're keeping the bar high while giving our builder partners the flexibility to achieve it in their own way. Integrity is what matters, and we're working with people we trust to deliver it."

Among those collaborators are Tract, our long-time landscape architects for Resolution projects. "They've been with us on many projects," Frazer notes. "We trust their advice, and they know how we work. That relationship means the landscape is a key part of what makes the entire neighbourhood stand apart and look its best. We want people who live here to be proud of the place they call home."

Asked how he would describe the feeling of returning to that home at the end of the day, Jeremy pauses, then smiles. "You'll be pulling into a vibrant, ready-to-go on-the-ground lifestyle. It's not a paddock with a promise. It's a neighbourhood that feels alive from the start."

## A Natural Setting

Viridian is designed to be vibrant, connected, and alive, a place where nature and community grow together.

The landscape is a key aspect of what makes Viridian unique. To understand how it has been shaped, we sat down with Eric Balakas, Associate Landscape Architect at Tract, to hear more about the vision behind the design.

#### What role does the landscape play at Viridian?

At Viridian, the landscape is the heart of the community. Inspired by its name, the development integrates lush greenery with Greenvale's natural surroundings. A north–south walking and cycling spine runs through the community, promoting healthy, active lifestyles.

#### How is the open space designed?

Three open spaces form the anchor of the development, with two linear reserves connecting to a primary local park bordered by the Blossom Drive Conservation Reserve. This layout offers residents direct access to nature, with formal and informal paths inviting exploration and immersion in the landscape.

#### How have you incorporated the area's landscape?

A key feature is the preservation of mature River Red Gums (Eucalyptus camaldulensis), which enhance biodiversity and character while providing shaded retreats. These trees form a green corridor that links people, wildlife, and a sense of place.

#### What can you tell us about the choice of plants?


The planting palette is proudly native with a blend of complementary exotics, focusing on local indigenous species that showcase Australia's seasonal beauty. A gardenesque style adds richness and habitat value throughout the reserves.

#### What will residents experience when they arrive at Viridian?

The southern entry from Somerton Road will feature a signature landscape feature, welcoming residents home with a sense of pride in their address.

#### How would you describe the overall vision?

Viridian is designed to be vibrant, connected, and alive — a place where nature and community grow together.

#### Recreation

Active living is part of the Greenvale experience.

With **Greenvale Recreation Reserve** just across the road, residents can enjoy facilities for tennis, cricket, football, and equestrian activities, where you can join a club or use all the facilities on offer. Check out our special feature, Meet Your Neighbours, to find out more.

The kids will enjoy the **Section Road Adventure Playground**, which is fenced for safety. And if you're looking for an open space to walk the dog, there is even a designated off-leash dog walking area.

Viridian kids have some excellent playground options within a 5-minute walk from home. **Straw Flower Circuit Playground** and **Greenvale Gardens Playgrounds** are both established and offer a variety of activities and seating areas for all the family to enjoy.

Let's not forget about **Woodlands Historic National Park**, which is ideal for hiking and spotting kangaroos. Or head to Greenvale Reservoir, which offers views of the water, picnic areas with park facilities, and a walking track.

The **Greenvale Recreation Centre** offers some indoor multi-purpose courts for basketball, netball, and volleyball, as well as spaces for gatherings and community events.

#### **Public Transport**

Getting around is simple and efficient.
With established public transport options on your doorstep, daily commutes and weekend outings become easy, freeing more time for the life you want.

Roxburgh Park Train Station links you directly to Melbourne's CBD. The nearby bus route 543 connects the community to Roxburgh Park Train and Shopping Centre and travels up to Craigieburn Central Shopping Centre.

If you're coming from the Airport, there's the 901 bus to catch or a quick Uber or Taxi.

#### Roads

Residents at Viridian have easy access to Mickleham Road, which links
Greenvale to the Tullamarine Freeway and the Western Ring Road, enhancing connectivity and providing an essential connection to wider metropolitan Melbourne and the CBD.

The new intersection at Somerton & Mickleham Roads is now completed, as part of Stage 1 – Mickleham Road Upgrade, making your daily commutes flow more smoothly.

#### Walking & Cycling

Viridian connects to a well-established cycling and pedestrian network, enabling safe and efficient movement within the local community.

This network meanders through established open spaces along Greenvale Reservoir and Woodland's Reserve.

Riding or walking to **Keelonith Primary School** is a leisurely 5-minute wander through **Blossom Reserve**. On your way, explore the laneway parks, stop by the parks and playgrounds.



## Learning for Every Stage of Life

At Viridian, a wide range of prestigious educational options is available for every level of learning.

#### **Early Learning**

Greenvale offers a strong start for young families, with over 12 daycare options within a 5-minute drive of Viridian.

This includes **Explorers Early Learning and Early Beginners Child Care Centre**.

Each provides nurturing environments that encourage curiosity, independence, and social development from the beginning.

#### **Primary Schools**

**Keelonith Primary School** is within walking distance of Viridian. It opened in 2021 and is a Supported Inclusion School designed with open-plan classrooms, sensory spaces, and a curriculum that promotes inquiry-based learning.

**Greenvale Primary School**, a wellestablished local institution, is known for its strong literacy and numeracy programs alongside a welcoming community culture.

Mary Queen of Heaven and St Carlo Borromeo Primary Schools are two Catholic education options, located close to Viridian.

#### **Secondary Schools**

Aitken College offers a co-educational pathway from Prep to Year 12 on a 44-acre campus featuring state-of-theart science and technology labs, as well as a performing arts centre and sports grounds.

**Greenvale Secondary College**, which opened in 2022, offers STEM-focused facilities, landscaped outdoor learning spaces, and additional amenities.

For families seeking an independent school, **Kolbe Catholic College** is a Year 7-12 co-educational school with a curriculum that offers an Accelerated Learning Program, **Liverpool Football Club International Academy**, and Performing Arts, with a focus on Student Wellbeing and Community.

#### **Tertiary Education**

For higher learning, Viridian residents enjoy access to leading adult Education institutions.

Kangan Institute campus at
Broadmeadows is renowned for learning excellence in trades, design, health, and community services, offering practical training that leads to workplace success.

The **Northern Study Hub** has recently opened in both Broadmeadows and Epping, bringing more tertiary education options to the area.



#### **Greenvale Recreation Reserve**

Just minutes from Viridian, Greenvale Recreation Reserve is the hub of local community sport and recreation.

As well as open spaces and walking paths, it's home to the Greenvale Jets Football Club and the Kangaroos Cricket Club. The Greenvale Tennis Club has begun its upgrade with a new \$315,000 Clubhouse and two new courts, supported by Hume City Council.

Bring your family's four-legged friend to the dedicated dog off-leash area. The reserve also features Section Rd. Adventure Playground, Greenvale Pony and Equestrian Club, and the Hume Indoor Cricket Centre, which provides year-round training for cricketers.

#### **Woodlands Historic Park**

Only a short drive away, Woodlands Historic Park is a sanctuary of nature and history.


Climb Gellibrand Hill for panoramic views across
Melbourne or explore the walking tracks that range from
30 minutes to three hours. Birdwatchers will find native
species throughout the park, while horse riding and
cycling trails add variety for active explorers.

Shaded picnic areas with barbecue facilities make it a welcoming spot for family outings, too. Woodlands is a place to recharge in nature and see kangaroos without leaving the neighbourhood behind.

#### **Greenvale Reservoir Park**





The park's expansive lawns and serene setting make it an ideal spot for picnics, weekend walks, or simply taking in the natural beauty of the area. And for those on two wheels, there are plenty of cycling trails to explore.

#### **Marnong Estate**

Not far from Viridian in nearby
Mickleham, Marnong Estate combines
vineyard beauty, historic charm and
contemporary dining. With views of the
Macedon Ranges, the estate has evolved
into a destination that attracts visitors
for its exceptional food, wine, and a
range of events.

At the heart of the experience is La Vètta, Marnong's chef-hatted Italian restaurant. Its menu celebrates seasonality and provenance, with handmade pastas, wood-fired meats and produce-led dishes matched with wines grown on the estate. For something more relaxed, Cucina 3064 and Caffè Vista provide casual dining options, offering everything from share plates to family-friendly meals.


The cellar door rounds out the experience with tastings of cool-climate wines that reflect the unique character of the land.

#### **Living Legends**

Located in Greenvale, Living Legends combines heritage, wildlife and community charm in one setting. At its heart is Woodlands Homestead, a historic property where champion racehorses live out their retirement and where visitors can enjoy open space, gardens and native bush.

Guided tours introduce the horses and share their stories. Families can explore bushland trails, spot kangaroos and birdlife, and spend time inside the homestead itself. The café is a popular stop for light meals, snacks and traditional Devonshire Tea, all served with views across the surrounding parkland.

Living Legends also offers visitor packages designed to suit different interests. Experiences such as Grand Day Out, Meet and Mingle and A Family Affair invite guests to connect with the horses, the gardens and the wider landscape in new ways. The homestead and grounds also provide a setting for weddings, parties and corporate functions, creating memorable occasions in a distinctly local environment.

For Viridian residents, Living Legends is a destination to visit often. It is a place to share a meal, enjoy nature and bring family or friends together. Having a venue like this nearby means that heritage, wildlife and a sense of escape are part of everyday life in Greenvale.

#### **Viridian for Families**

Greenvale is built for family life:
expansive parklands (including
Woodlands Historic Park), active sporting
reserves and local recreation facilities sit
alongside well-regarded schools such as
Aitken College, and all within easy reach
of everyday shops and medical services.

#### **Viridian for First Home Buyers**

Viridian gives first home buyers a clear pathway: entry-level land opportunities remain competitive (median vacant-land price for late-2024 was around \$416k) while nearby resale housing in Greenvale trades in the mid-to-upper \$800ks — a mix that supports both affordable build options and household equity growth as the area matures.

#### **Viridian for Investors**

Greenvale delivers rental demand and yield metrics that matter. Median weekly asking rents for the postcode 3059 sit around \$617–\$650 pw, producing implied gross yields in the ~3.7–4.1% range depending on dwelling type — backed by low vacancy pressure across Melbourne's north.

Proximity to Melbourne Airport and direct road links to the CBD help sustain both tenant demand and longer-term capital prospects.

#### **Employment**

This area provides a strong mix of current and future employment opportunities, with Greenvale West alone set to create around 250 new jobs through upcoming schools, retail, and community facilities. Craigieburn's bustling town centre offers roles across retail, hospitality, healthcare, and professional services,

while the nearby northern industrial corridor delivers extensive opportunities in manufacturing, logistics, and distribution. With Melbourne Airport, major business parks, and key freeways within a short drive, as well as rail access from Craigieburn and Roxburgh Park stations, residents have excellent connectivity to major employment hubs across Melbourne.




